1. Financial:

- A. <u>Financial Report Form</u>: This form is found on the SIJHSAA Website. Please complete and return the report and your check to the SIJHSAA within 15 days of the conclusion of your tournament.
- B. <u>Game Ball:</u> Regional hosts will receive a Rawlings basketball at no charge from your regional organizer. [Rawlings CNTR295-SIJHSAA (boys) / Rawlings CNTR285-SIJHSAA (girls)]
- C. <u>Admission Prices:</u> Students (K-8) \$2 Adults (High School Students and above) \$3 *It is suggested that the gates open 1 hour before the games start.
 D. Passos: The only passos that will be benered are SUHSAA Board of
- D. <u>Passes:</u> The only passes that will be honored are SIJHSAA Board of Control Member Passes or Steering Committee Member Passes.
 *All other passes aren't honored.
- E. <u>Pass Gate List:</u> (Make sure participating schools dressed players, cheerleaders in uniform, coaches, administrators, and athletic directors are admitted at no charge/a pass gate list form is on the website if needed)

2. TOURNAMENT PLANNING:

- A. <u>Playing Dates:</u> Playing dates should be communicated to all participating teams. Stay within your regional window that is listed on your regional groupings page.
- B. <u>Brackets:</u> Brackets may be found on the SIJHSAA Website to formulate your tournament.
 - *Top team of the bracket is home team.
- C. <u>Tournament Time Schedule:</u>
 - 1. It is typical to schedule games 1 hour and 15 minutes apart.
 - 2. All games consist of 7 minutes periods.
 - 3. Overtime periods length 3 minutes.
 - 4. Warm-up period typically 15 minutes.
 - 5. Halftime periods 10 minutes.
- D. <u>Playing Floor:</u>
 - 1. A 28ft coaching box must be marked on your floor. (End line to 28 ft. on side of court benches are located)
 - 2. An X should be placed on the floor in front of your scorer, but off the playing floor for substitutions.
- E. <u>Bench Officials</u>: It is very important to have reliable personnel at the bench as your official scorer and timer. <u>The official scorer</u> <u>must wear a black and striped vest or shirt</u>. (NFHS Rule 2-11-11) The official scorer and timer should be at the bench no later than 20 minutes before the game begins.

*It is suggested that the official scorer and timer for regional games be at least 16 years of age.

3. TOURNAMENT POLICIES:

- A. <u>Banners, Signs, Noise Makers, etc.</u>: Please read over SIJHSAA By Law Article IV-Sec. 7. Banners, signs, shakers, noisemakers, etc. are prohibited. Such devices obstruct the view of spectators, are unsightly, and in many instances may become safety hazards.
- B. <u>"Mercy Rule"</u>: The SIJHSAA has adopted the rule in the basketball state series.
- C. <u>Rawlings Advertising:</u> If programs are produced, the Rawlings Advertisement should be included in the program.
- D. <u>Cheerleaders</u>: A maximum of 15 cheerleaders may be in uniform. During live ball times, only 8 cheerleaders may be standing to cheer. Mascots count as one of the 8 standing during live ball times.
- E. <u>Ejections</u>: If a player, coach, or fan is ejected from a contest for unsportsmanlike conduct, the host of the regional is responsible to complete the Unsportsmanlike Conduct Form. Please fax or e-mail it to my office no later than 10am of the day following the ejection. [sijhsaa@gmail.com (e-mail) / 618-357-2987 (fax)]
- F. <u>Uniforms:</u> Note: Shorts may be rolled up to allow for a better fitting uniform. Strings must be tucked in to the shorts, pants, or skirts.
- 4. PA & AWARDS:
 - A. <u>Rawlings "Official Ball of the SIJHSAA" Announcement:</u> If a PA System is used, the Rawlings Ball Announcement must be read one(1) time per game.
 - B. <u>Starting Lineup Sheet:</u> If a PA System is used the SIJHSAA provides a sportsmanship announcement to read previous to the starting starting lineups.
 - C. <u>Regional Championship Trophy:</u> The regional championship trophy should be presented at the conclusion of the championship game. *Your Regional Organizer will have the regional trophy.

5. OFFICIALS:

- A. <u>Hiring</u>: It is the regional host's responsibility to contract officials.
 - 1. Officials must be registered by the Illinois High School Association. *Check IHSA licensing on the SIJHSAA Website with your user id. and password.
 - 2. Make sure that the officials that you are hiring are approved by all teams in your regional.
 - 3. Preferably, no officials hired should have an affiliation with any of the participating schools. (ie.-children attending school, employee of the district, etc.)
 - 4. 2 man officiating crews will be used at the regional level.
- B. <u>Payment:</u> Regional officials should be paid \$55.00 each for each game.
- C. <u>Pre-Game Meeting</u>: Please remind your officials that it is required

that a pre-game meeting be held with the head coaches, captains, and officials.
